ServSafe Food Handler Program

- The ServSafe Food Handler program delivers consistent food safety training to employees, consumers, and volunteers involved with the preparation and serving of food.
- A certificate is provided to each student that completes the training.
- Helps employees identify and control risk within your operation.
- The training covers basic food safety, personal hygiene, cross-contamination and allergens, time and temperature, and cleaning and sanitation.
- Classes are taught in English. The ServSafe Food Handler curriculum is available in English & Spanish.
- ServSafe was developed by industry, for industry, and gives back to industry through the Educational Foundation.

Registration Policies
